Eligibility

To be eligible for the student travel grant the applicant **must** 1) be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident, 2) have been enrolled as a student at the time he/she submitted their paper for consideration to the 2014 ISFA, 3) register for the 2014 ISFA, and 4) present his/her paper at the 2014 ISFA.

Submission

Submit your application via email as a pdf file to **Dr. Robert G. Landers** (landersr@mst.edu) no later than one week after you have been notified that your paper has been accepted.

Review Process

All applications will be reviewed and successful applicants will be notified at least one week before the camera-ready manuscript submission deadline.

Eligible Expenses

Expenses eligible for reimbursement include economy class travel, lodging (up to three nights), and the cost of regular student registration. Expenses **not** eligible for reimbursement include late registration costs, meals, parking, and local transportation.

Reimbursement

The level of support for each student will be approximately \$1,500. The exact amount will depend on the available funds and the number of successful applicants. Reimbursement will be made after the conference, upon receipt of all required documentation. You will receive instructions for obtaining your reimbursement at the same time you receive notification that your application has been accepted.
